### What is the PE and Sport Premium?

The government is spending over £450 million on improving Physical Education (PE) and sport in primary schools. The funding must be used to fund improvements to the provision of PE and sport, so they develop healthy lifestyles.

Samuel Lucas received £18,730 for the academic year 2017-2018.

The school achieved the bronze School Games Mark award for commitment and development of sport and PE in the school. Following this the school will be aiming to achieve the gold award in 2018/2019.

During the school year to promote health and fitness we arranged a visit by Daniel Lewis who represented Great Britain in the Commonwealth games. He gave an inspirational talk about his journey to success and led a fitness activity with each class.
