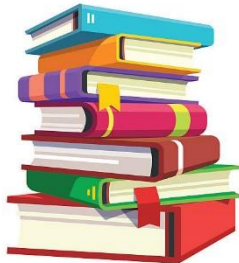
Throughout the year, they will support the school with the upkeep of the library, support individual classes with their reading and will promote a positive interest in new books. We all look forward to having you on the English team!
